His passion and commitment to the cause of improving the standard of cricket in the Sultanate distinguished him as one of the foundational pieces of Oman Cricket's success. He was also an affable and approachable man who brought zeal and energy to the workplace.

Iqbal's demise leaves an enormous void in the cricketing fraternity of the country. He has left an indelible mark on the sport and his contributions will continue to live on in the hearts and minds of everyone associated with the Oman Cricket family.

ADMINISTRATIVE NEWS

Vaishali Jesrani, Captain of the Oman Women's Cricket team was <u>announced</u> as manager of Team Spirit at the SDG FairBreak Invitational T20 Tournament held between May 1 and 15, 2022 in Dubai. The competition was the world's first privately funded tournament in women's cricket history and involved players from emerging cricket nations such as Philippines, Japan and Vanuatu, thus furthering its global growth and outreach.



INTERNATIONAL CRICKET ROUND-UP

In April, the Oman Men's National team <u>toured</u> UAE for a 4-match tri-series involving Scotland and PNG, with the matches played as part of the ICC Men's CWC League 2. They collected full points against the latter but fell just short in both games against Scotland. Jatinder Singh starred with bat in hand, scoring 259 runs in 4 outings. His 118-run knock against PNG became Oman's highest-ever individual tally in ODIs. Bilal Khan continued his hot streak with the ball and picked up 13 wickets over the same stretch. In the final game of the tri-series, he claimed his 3rd 5-wicket haul in the space of just 9 games.

Oman's next and final set of fixtures in the competition will get underway on June 8th, in the form of a double round-robin tri-series involving Nepal and hosts USA. They currently lead the standings by 16 points, having played 16 games more than second-placed Scotland. A good showing in the States will cement Oman's status as frontrunners to qualify for the ODI World Cup Qualifiers in India next year.

DOMESTIC CRICKET ROUND-UP – Division Finals

The finals of all the domestic competitions in the country's cricketing ladder were held in the first week of April. In the Premier Division, Oman Stallions clinched top spot while Muscat CT finished runners-up. Vanderlande came out on top in the Senior Knockout final and Israr Ghala were the champions of its junior counterpart. Zawawi Powertech won the A-Division 50-over season while Sarco LLC took the crown in its 20-over iteration. Al Jadidi Stars and Zawawi Powertech were the respective finalists.
